

## MARKET REPORT - WEEK 5

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 3RD FEBRUARY 2023.

Due to the Lunar New Year holidays over the past fortnight the freight and S+P markets have been somewhat lackluster, so we are anticipating a little more activity this week as the Far East comes back on stream. Nevertheless, last week saw the first Baltic dry freight index improvements of the year with the BSI and BHSI both improving slightly by +4.9% and +1.6% respectively. Overall however, the BDI continued to lose ground closing Friday down by a further -8.1% w-o-w due to the BCI shedding another -19.6% and the BPI -10.8%. Handys through to Kamsarmaxes are now fixing only in the \$7,000 and 8,000s daily while the Capes are now only earning mid \$3,000s, so the hope is that only the PRC's weather balloon (over USA) has burst, leaving rested and reenergized China trade to spark some life back into the shipping markets.

Challenging conditions continue in the recycling centers of the subcontinent where the IMF has intervened over the past week. In Bangladesh to positive effect due to the IMF authorizing a \$4.7 billion loan as a 'stabilization package' for its finances which in turn will improve the countries bank's willingness to issue the LC's required for their recyclers to buy foreign owner ships for scrap. In Pakistan however, the IMF rejected the country's proposed 'circular debt management plan' leaving its domestic steel industry in a perilous position and the Bank of Pakistan continuing to refuse to issue LCs, which in turn means that Pakistani breakers remain unable to even bid for vessels at this time. India's recyclers meantime look set for very productive times ahead due to their government announcing huge further capital investments in their railways, plus 50 new airports and additional infrastructure which will lead to a significant rise in domestic steel consumption. In turn this means that Indian breakers are going to be well financed and keen to secure tonnage during 2023.
