

MARKET REPORT - WEEK 50

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 13TH DECEMBER 2024.

How Syria will be governed and by who exactly is still unknown as its only a week since Assad and his family ran to Russia where he reportedly sent about 2 tons of bank notes totaling about \$200 million in cash during 2018-2019 in order to buy Russian favour and military assistance at that time. His regime has left Syria in tatters with civil war breaking out in some areas while neighboring countries also bomb its arms and chemical weapon stores in order to stop them falling into the wrong hands and being used against the Syrian people again or anyone else. One bonus is that with Assad gone, Russia and Iran can no longer use Syria as a conduit for supplying weaponry etc to Hezbollah in Lebanon while at the same time Hamas in Gaza and the Houthis in Yemen have also been severely weakened. Another possible result is that Russia could end up being denied the use of its military port and airport at respectively Tartus and Latakia in western Syria but it is currently too early to know how the balance of power will develop in that country.

The dry freight market continues to slip with the BDI posting a further -9.9% w-o-w decline closing on Friday on 1051 points which is almost exactly half the 2110 points if closed on at the end of week 1 of 2024. All Baltic dry indexes lost further ground last week with the BCI closing down -17.7%, the BPI -6.7%, the BSI -1.5% and the BHSI -4.0%, which equates to current average daily t/c rates or about \$10,500 for Capes, \$9,000 for Kamsarmaxes, \$12,100 for Ultramaxes and \$11,100 for large (38k) Handysizes.

S+P activity last week was by far the lowest for the year with only about two tankers and five bulkers reportedly agreeing to change hands and we are noticing a marked reduction in S+P related purchase enquiry at the moment with buyers probably looking forward to picking up some post-Christmas bargain vessels in the sales.

In the subcontinent recycling sector it should be borne in mind that all breaking yards there will have to comply with the HKC 'green' rules within the next 6 months. We understand that nearly all Indian yards have already made the required investment in their sites and have their class certification in place, whereas Bangladesh is still some way behind and in Pakistan, where only 16 vessels have been purchased for recycling in the whole of 2024, there has been almost no such investment so far and will bring about their yards closures if they don't comply.

We also understand that a number of large LDT 'dark fleet' vessels will be looking for 'end of life beach locations' in coming months, which may not be so straight forward due to expected tightening of rules on vessels that have been assisting Russia and Iran to circumvent Western sanctions. The likelihood is that these vessels will have to be sold to breakers at far less than prevailing market levels and even then, because of their higher LDTs / cost, it will be difficult for breakers in Bangladesh and Pakistan to open such high value L/Cs, leaving India as the most likely beneficiary of most of them.
